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5. Have you encountered discrimination, prejudice or racism? How do you respond to that?

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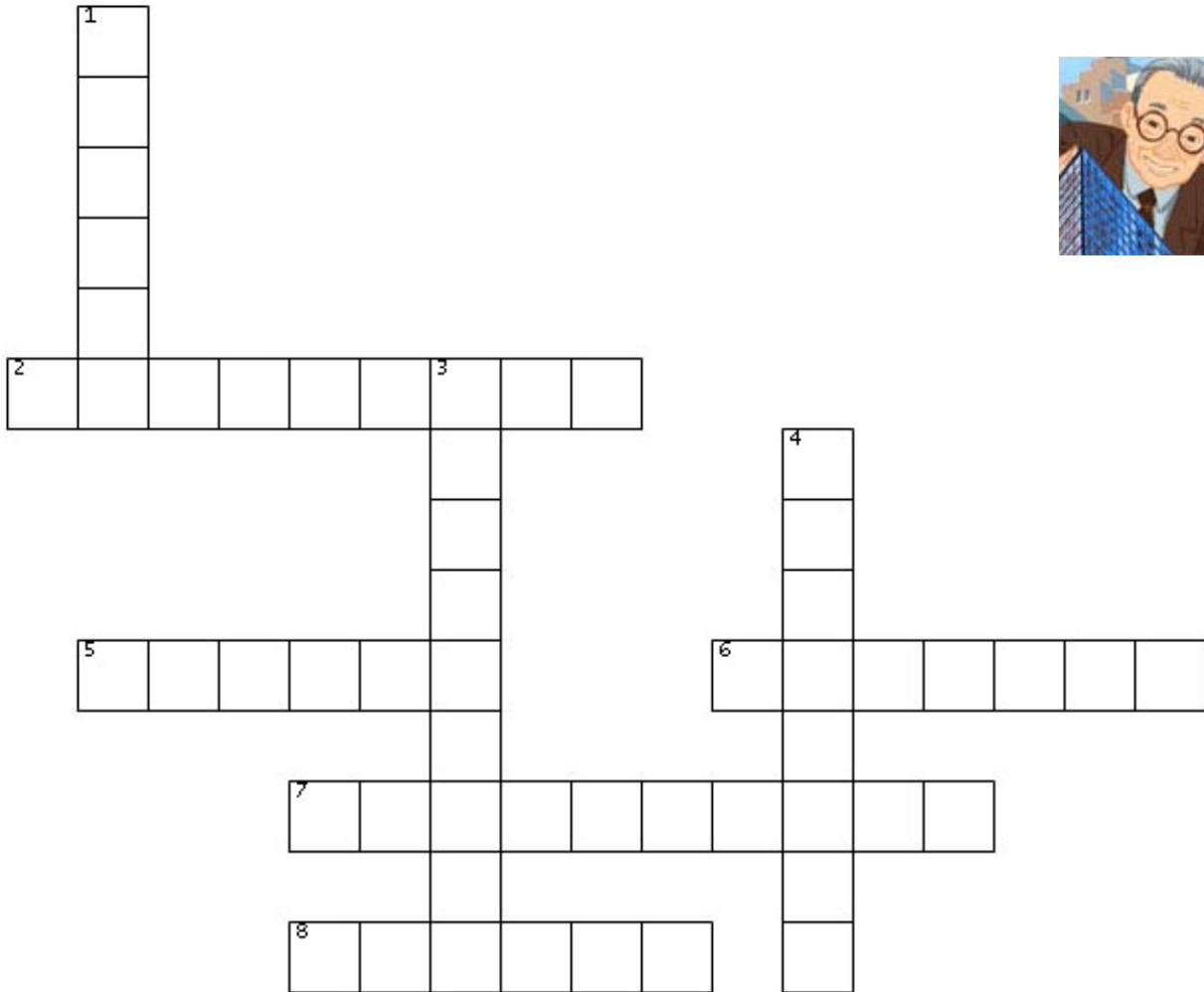
6. What do you dream of becoming or doing? What kind of skills will you need to achieve those goals?

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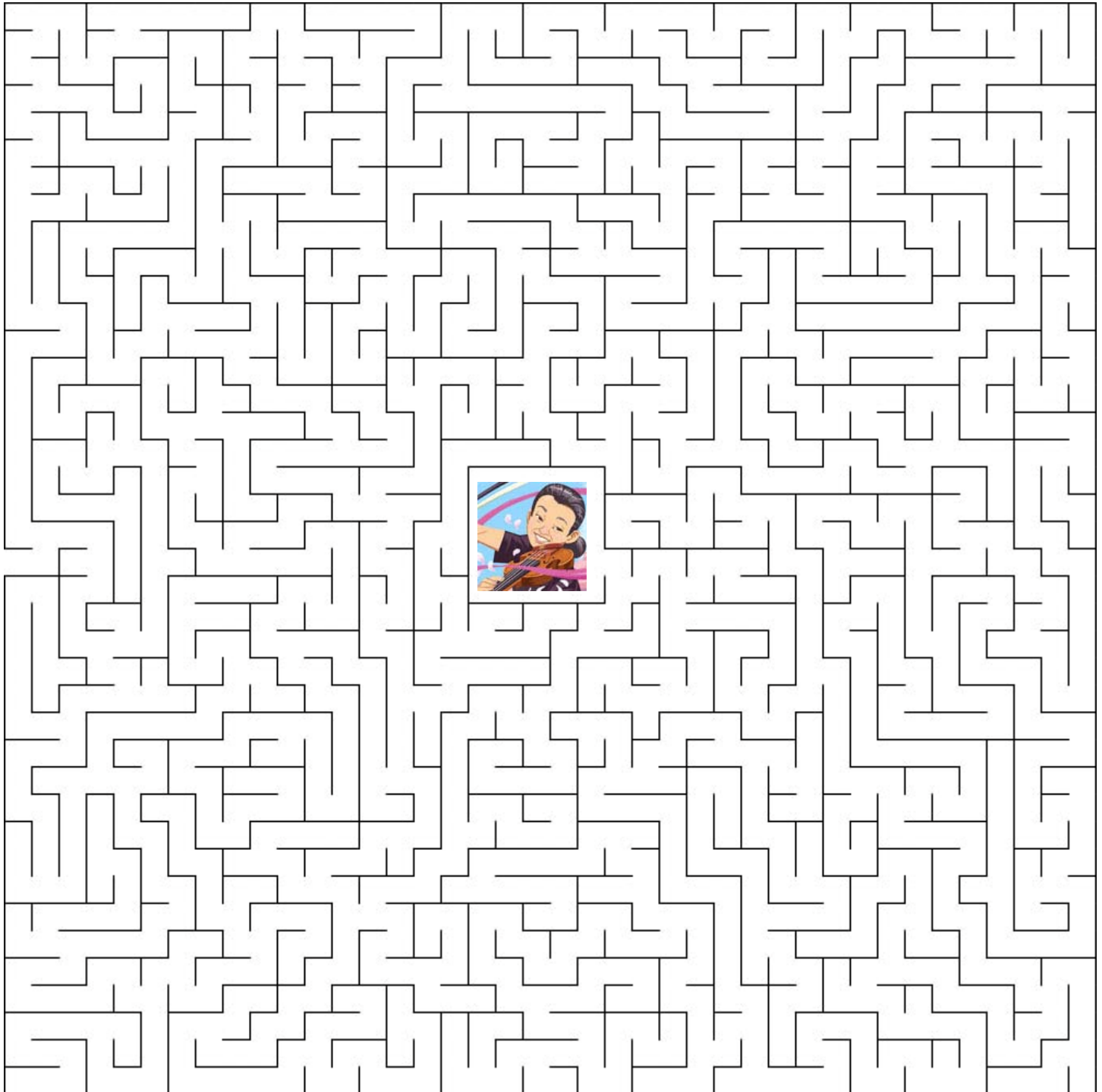
